



1) From the VLeBooks homepage, select OpenAthens under Sign in below.

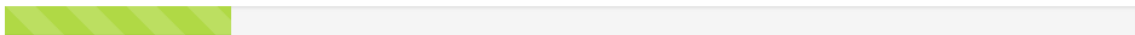
