In October 2024, the Antiquities and Monuments Office (AMO) of the Development Bureau announced the exciting news of the discovery of dinosaur fossils on Port Island in Hong Kong Geopark which highlighted Hong Kong's geological diversity and valuable geological heritage, sparking interest of many. With the support of Hong Kong Geopark, we have arranged an exciting boat trip to visit Port Island and other locations with sedimentary and/or fossil-bearing rocks. Geopark officers will introduce the recent discovery and initial research findings, current understanding of the depositional environment and likely processes associated with the formation of fossils, and a brief history of fossil discovery in Hong Kong.

Important notes:

- We will travel by boat to Port Island & surrounding islands, transfer between the passenger boat & smaller speedboat to reach the islands will be required participants with motion sickness is expect to bring their own medication.
- Please bring your own packed lunch & sufficient water/fluid for the whole trip.
- Sturdy footwear is recommended no sandals or flipflops allowed.
- Sunscreen and/or hats are recommended.

Successful applicants will be informed via email by 26 May and deposit payment to be paid by 30 May to confirm your seat.


Members attending the event will receive a full refund of their deposit.
